Macomb County's largest American Polish Festival scheduled for July 7-9, 2017

The 37th annual American Polish Festival and Craft Show will be held on the grounds of the American Polish Century Club in Sterling Heights (14 Mile Rd & Hoover). Attendance of over 15,000 people is expected to enjoy all that the festival has to offer. Admission is ONLY \$2 per person, FREE parking and no charge for those 17 and under.

The American Polish Century Club is continuing to give back to the community by hosting this much anticipated event with a first class line up of bands and events. The Club takes pride in serving their homemade Polish cuisine and members will be working long hours making over 5,000 Golabki, over one ton of city chicken, 750 pounds of potato pancakes and more than 20,000 pierogi.

The weekend features the area's largest wooden dance floor in southeastern Michigan that will feature bands from across the country.
